

**INFORMATION ON THE CHESTERFIELD HOSPITAL RE-DEVELOPMENT
PROJECT**Friday 1st March 2013

Dear Neighbour,

Today and continuing through tomorrow morning, we will be undertaking some enhancement works to improve the pedestrian footpath and hauling way on the section of Clifton Hill adjacent to the main site compound. The section between number 4 and the boundary retaining wall of the Chesterfield site will be resurfaced and we will endeavour to undertake these works with the minimum of disruption.

The week ahead Monday 4th to Saturday 9th March

- Internal and external refurbishment works on the Grade II* listed building will be on-going.
- Roofing replacement works to the final element of the former Clifton Court manor house will continue, now that the temporary over-roof has been installed.
- Construction of external and internal walls to the new building are now well underway and will continue, as will the mechanical and electrical fit out works. This work will now be on-going for the foreseeable future.
- Scaffolding will continue to be erected around the whole of the new hospital building.
