

## INFORMATION ON THE CHESTERFIELD HOSPITAL RE-DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

### Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> September

- There will be a small crew on site laying concrete foundations for the stable block extension. This will involve deliveries of ready-mix concrete during the morning.



The picture above shows how the basement floor slab is cast in sections on top of a layer of re-enforcing mesh, using ready-mix concrete pumped down from road level.

### The week ahead

- Works should complete on the foundation slab of the new building.
- Ready-mix concrete lorries will be delivering to site throughout the week.
- A small number of deliveries of re-enforcement bar will also take place.
- Installation of site wide drainage will continue.
- Works on the foundations of the stable block extension will continue.
- A very small amount of spoil being generated on site will be removed using the muck-away lorries
- A reminder that a Public Information Meeting is being held on Wednesday in Clifton Hill House, full details attached.
