

## INFORMATION ON THE CHESTERFIELD HOSPITAL RE-DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Dear Neighbour,

### The week ahead Monday 25<sup>th</sup> to Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> March

- Internal and external refurbishment works on the Grade II\* listed building will be on-going.
- Roofing replacement works to the final element of the former Clifton Court manor house will continue, now that the temporary over-roof has been installed.
- Construction of external and internal walls to the new building are now well underway and will continue, as will the mechanical and electrical fit out works. This work will now be on-going for the foreseeable future.
- Scaffolding is now being erected around the whole of the new hospital and once complete will be covered in a monoflex weather protective shroud.
- The new electricity sub-station has been successfully craned into position on the far corner of the site adjacent to Saville Place. The unit will now be fully encased in a GRP enclosure.
