INFORMATION ON THE CHESTERFIELD HOSPITAL RE-DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Dear Neighbour,

The week ahead Monday 29th April to Saturday 4th May

- Works to the new hospital are progressing, with the internal partitions now starting to be formed on the second floor. A crane to assist the works will be delivered on Monday 29th April.
- Mechanical and Electrical works are continuing with the larger elements of the equipment within the basement now in place. Electricity works to the new hospital are now complete.
- The roof finishes on the Stable Block have now been removed and works to refurbish it are ongoing.
- Refurbishment works to the Grade II listed building are still continuing and following the arrival of the external site cabins, more intensive works can now take place to the ground floor rooms.
- Water connection works at the Fosseway Gate are starting w/c 29th April and to mitigate any disruption Vinci have allowed access through the entire site.
