# Clifton Village Cycle Stands

April 2015



As part of the Bristol City Council's long-term commitment to improving facilities for sustainable transport, the council proposes to increase the number of cycle parking stands in Clifton Village.

Overleaf is a plan of the proposed cycle parking locations

We will install hoop shaped (Sheffield) stands, to match those existing. The stand dimensions are 700mm x 700mm and made from stainless steel tubing.



The provision of cycle parking will:

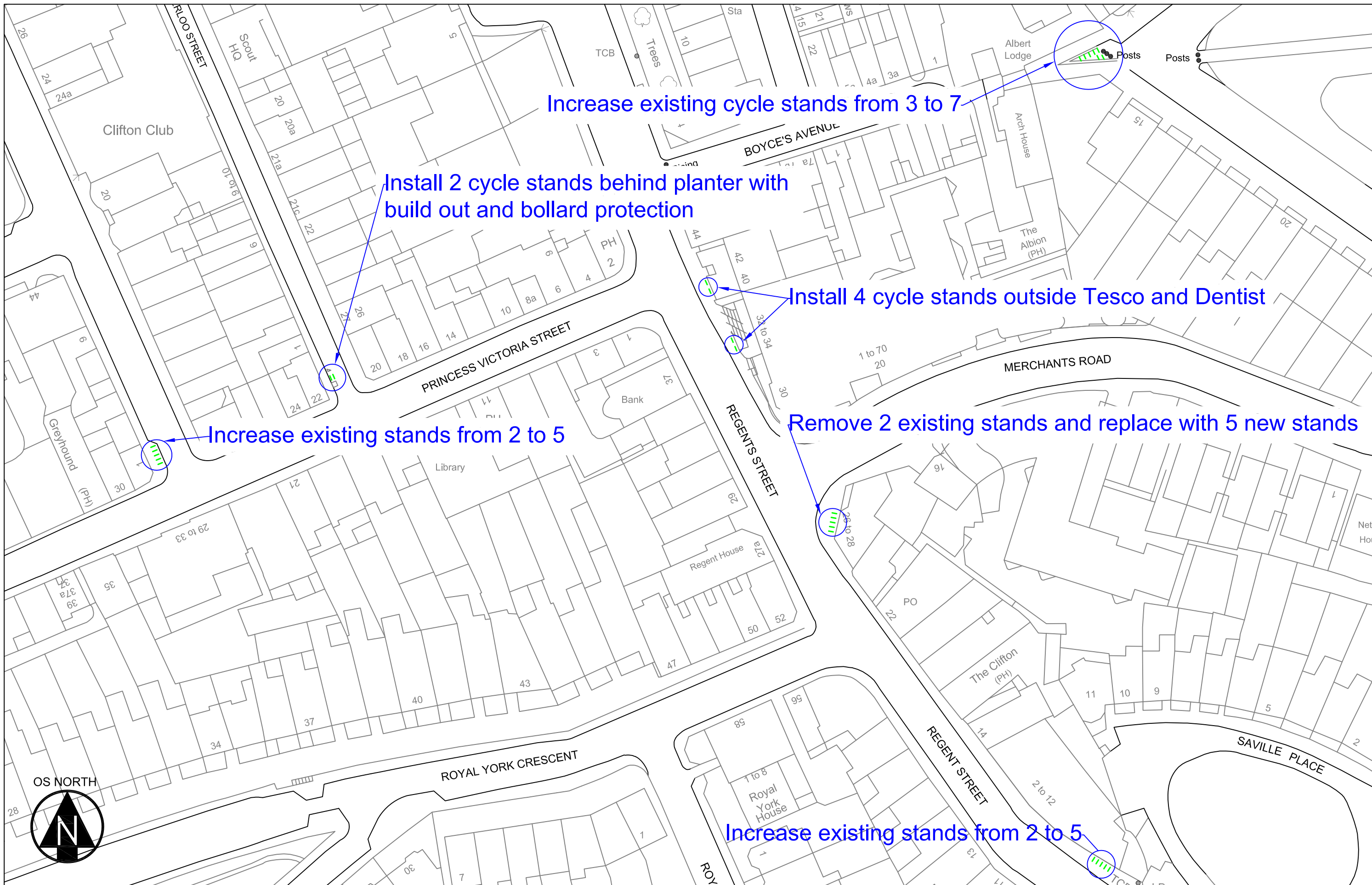
Promote cycling as a sustainable mode of transport.

Improve local trade, as more people would be encouraged to leave their bicycles in a secure location.

Discourage cyclists from parking their bikes in unintended locations such as privately-owned railings road signs and against shop windows.
